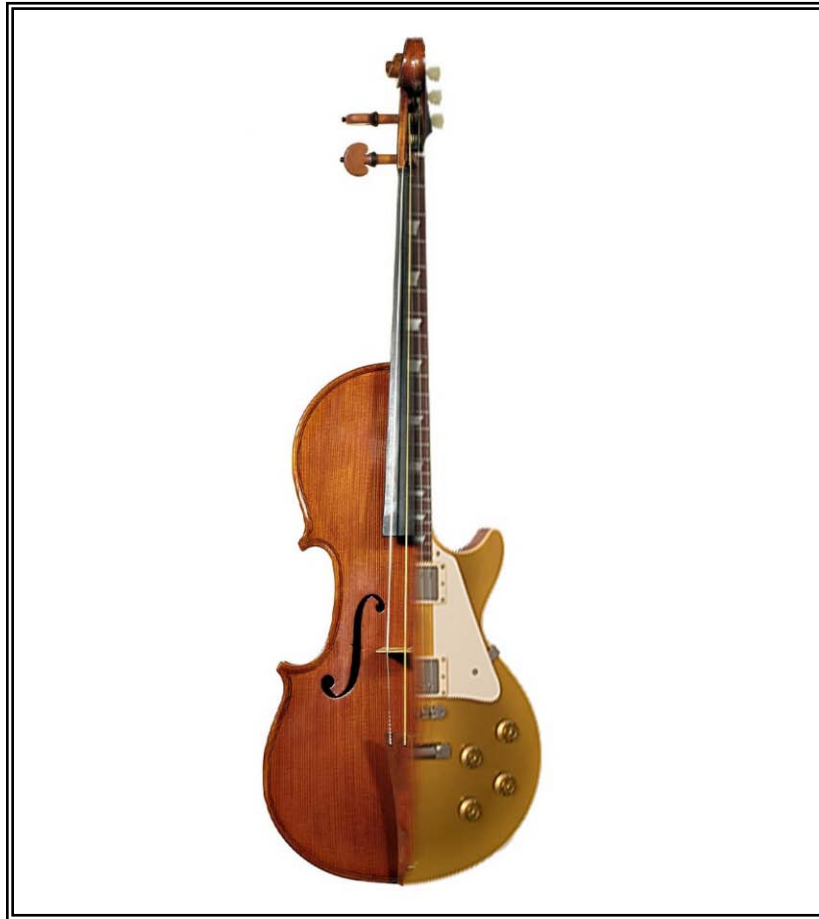


Fox Valley Music Camp 2011 at Judson University

Younger students will explore music basics, focusing on fun rhythm games, simple instrument building, singing - and lots of FUN! These budding musicians will perform a group recital for family and friends at the end of the week.

Entering 3rd - 5th Grades Full-Day Camp

\$200*

*(Lunch included)

This age group will focus on music fundamentals including music history, recorder instruction, singing and fun games. Optional private lessons are also available for students studying an instrument (additional \$50 for two 30-minute private lessons). A recital will conclude the week.

Entering 6th - 12th Grades Full-Day Camp

\$250*

*(Private lessons and lunch included)

Older students will explore how music has changed - and stayed the same -through the centuries. Students will compose their own music using the MIDI lab. Two 30-minute private lessons taught by Judson faculty are included. Instruction on most band and orchestra instruments, piano, guitar and voice (high school only) is available. Small ensembles will be formed.

IMEA Audition Prep: includes mock auditions and preparation of audition material through both ensemble rehearsals and instrument-specific assistance in sectionals. This program is open to Junior High strings and all Senior High orchestral instrumentalists who intend to audition for District and All State Competitions in the fall of 2011. Professor Joanna Newby will again be directing this successful program.

Classical and Contemporary tracks available:

Classical Track: for older students interested in pursuing a traditional band/orchestra instrument, piano, percussion and ensemble work. Also for IMEA Prep students.

Contemporary Track: for older students interested in forming a worship band with instruction in electric or acoustic guitar, electric keyboard and drums.

Since 2005, The Fox Valley Music Camp has been providing an enriching music education experience to budding musicians, ages K-12th grade. Staffed by Judson's accomplished music faculty, the camp is a vehicle to share their knowledge, mentorship and musicianship with the community at large.

DR. ERNEST "CHIP" GROSS is the chairman of the Music Department at Judson University. He teaches brass, music history, music appreciation, music education and conducting. He also directs the Judson University Symphonic Band and the Judson University Community Orchestra.

DR. JOSH JONES is a singer and composer. He teaches voice, opera, music theory and composition and music technology at Judson University. He has also served as music director and conductor for various stage productions and small ensembles.
