Being a part of the Judson University community means that each of us must take extraordinary steps to stay well and protect each other, both on campus and in the community. Members of our community are reminded that in their conduct, whether on campus or off, they are representatives of Judson. It is the responsibility of each community member to adhere to this pledge to protect our on-campus community and the community at large.

I pledge to take responsibility for my own health and the protection of others, and I pledge to help keep the Judson University community safe from the spread of COVID-19 and other infections. As a member of the Judson University community, I pledge to:

PROTECT MYSELF

- Monitor myself for symptoms of COVID-19 through daily symptom checking and following University instructions and guidelines, and seeking medical attention if necessary.
- Wash my hands often with soap and water. Use hand sanitizer when it is available.
- Seriously consider getting vaccinated for the flu in the fall.

PROTECT OTHERS

- Maintain appropriate physical distancing both indoors and outdoors.
- Stay home, or in my Residence Hall room if I feel ill or after exposure to someone who is ill or has tested positive for COVID-19.
- Wear an appropriate facial covering and other protective gear in public areas and inside all buildings as well as outdoors when social distancing cannot be maintained.

PROTECT OUR COMMUNITY

- Greet without shaking hands.
- Respect personal space and practice the six-foot physical distancing rule.
- Practice good hygiene.
- Disinfect my residence hall living space and personal items I bring to class regularly.
- Work to mitigate spread of germs on frequently touched surfaces and object.

The university expects all members of our community to adhere to this pledge both on and off-campus. Students who don't adhere to this pledge may be subject to judicial sanction.
