Art and Design Merit Scholarship

Portfolio Guidelines:

The Department of Art and Design at Judson University offers annual Merit Scholarships to incoming students majoring in Art, Studio Art, Graphic Design, Art: Photography, and Art: Film and Video. The award is competitive, based on portfolio evaluation, and is renewable for up to four years, provided the recipient continues as an Art and Design major, maintains a gpa of 3.00 in their Art and Design coursework, 2.5 overall, and complies with the stipulations of the Scholarship Agreement for Art and Design Merit Scholars. You must be **admitted** to Judson University **before** you can apply for this scholarship.

Deadline:

Portfolios will be evaluated on or shortly after **January 30** of every academic year. The final result of this evaluation will be communicated to you shortly after evaluations are completed. Scholarships are awarded based on the recommendations of the Department of Art and Design faculty and are forwarded to Financial Aid, which makes the final decision on the total amount of the scholarship.

To apply for this scholarship, please compile a CD-R that includes:

Portfolio Guidelines:

Your portfolio is to be submitted digitally on a CD-R and arrive in a protective jewel case. Multiple-page PDF format is preferred. JPEGs are acceptable. Each image or sample is to be labeled with the title of the piece, dimensions (H x W), the semester and year completed, and the medium or media used.

- * If you submit photography, please indicate whether the photos were produced digitally or in a darkroom.
- * If you do not have computer access, you may submit a portfolio of actual work, but the Department of Art and Design will not accept responsibility for lost or damaged work. If you submit original work, please arrange to pick it up in person or supply sufficient postage for its return.

Portfolio Contents:

You may submit 10-15 images of work in one or more of the following categories:

Drawing charcoal, graphite, colored pencil, ink, etc.

Paintingoil, acrylic, watercolorPhotographydarkroom or digitalIllustrationhand or digitally produced

Sculpture cast or constructed

Ceramicswheel-thrown or hand builtCollagehand or digitally crafted

Graphic Design typography, print, packaging, web

Film or Video no more than 15 minutes
