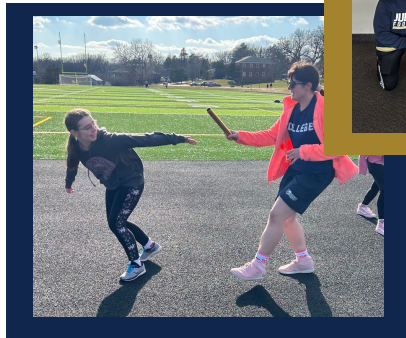
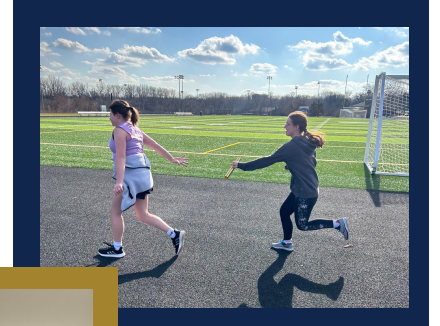

CELEBRATING JUDSON UNIVERSITY'S RISE PROGRAM

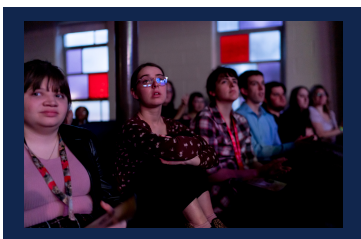
Special Olympics Track & Field
