Art and Design Merit Scholarship

The Art & Design Department at Judson University offers annual Merit Scholarships to incoming students majoring in Art, Studio Art, Graphic Design, and Art: Photography. The award is competitive, based on portfolio evaluation, and is renewable for up to four years, provided the recipient continues as an Art & Design major, maintains a GPA of 3.00 in their Art & Design coursework, a 2.5 GPA overall, and complies with the stipulations of the Scholarship Agreement for Art & Design Merit Scholars. You must be **admitted** to Judson University **before** applying for this scholarship. Scholarships are awarded based on the recommendations of Art & Design faculty in consultation with Financial Aid staff, who decide the final amount.

Submissions consist of the following:

- **Portfolio** representing your best work
- **Letter of interest** briefly introducing who you are and what you plan to study
- **Contact info** email, street address, phone

These may be compiled as a multiple-page PDF, or in a cloud folder (Google Drive, Dropbox, etc.). Email the PDF or link to the Chair of the Art & Design Department, who will review the materials.

Portfolio Guidelines:

The portfolio should be comprised of 12-15 images of works in one or more of the following areas:

- **Drawing** charcoal, graphite, colored pencil, ink, etc.
- **Painting** oil, acrylic, watercolor
- **Photography** darkroom or digital
- **Sculpture** cast or constructed
- **Ceramics** wheel-thrown or hand built
- **Collage** hand or digitally crafted
- **Graphic Design** typography, print, packaging, web

Each work is to be labeled with the following:

- **Title or description**
- **Year completed**
- **Dimensions** height in inches x width in inches (e.g. 18" x 24")
- **Medium or media** charcoal, acrylic or oil paint, digital or darkroom photography, etc.

Deadline:

Portfolios will be evaluated shortly after being received. The final results are typically communicated within a few weeks. Scholarships amounts may depend on available funds, as well as the quality of the portfolio, so applicants are encouraged to apply early.
